# ICUF Grants Final Emergency Relief Fund Payments

Earlier this month, the last round of Emergency Relief Fund grants were dispersed to Iowa credit union members in need. In all, the Emergency Relief Fund provided \$700,000 in grant relief to Iowans, including two \$25,000 gifts benefitting United Way's 2-1-1 program and the Iowa Community Action Association.
